IV. Meetings on Intangible Cultural heritage

There were two meetings recently held in Bangladesh realted to Intangible Cultural Heritage. One meeting was headed by the Secretary, Ministry of Cultural Affairs. High level Government officials from different Institutions like Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy, Bangla Academy, Bangladesh National Commission for UNESCO, Copy Right Office etc were present in the meeting. The meeting focused on ICH Convention and its implementation in Bangladesh. A sub-committe was formed in this meeting to formulate policy for the better implentation of ICH Convention.

Another meeting was the meeting of the Sub-Committee. This meeting ended with a decision to request Bangla Acdemy to translate the Convention into Bangla so that everybody related to ICH can better understand the Convention. Another imprtnat decision was taken in the meeting. That is to convene a large consultaion meeting with the heads of the relevant organisations both in GOs and NGOs.
