In Malaysia, activities related to intangible cultural heritage are often named under the umbrella of other names, such as traditional textiles, traditional crafts, local knowledge, traditional medicine, life ritual, traditional festivals, Malay Culture, South-east Asia Chinese culture, and so on. In fact, the term “intangible cultural heritage” was not very popular in Malaysia until end of 2015. Some 400 textile specialists, researchers, scholars and entrepreneurs, weavers, artisans, collectors, designers and students from 10 ASEAN countries participated in the symposium, along with textile experts and enthusiasts from Canada, United States of America, the Netherlands, United Kingdom, France, Japan and Germany. Her Royal Highness, Princess Azizah also attended the symposium. The symposium consisted of thematic visual presentations, demonstrations, site visits to weaving centers and a Culture of Clothing show.	
The theme of the symposium was Satu Rumpun, Satu Warisan (One Root, Shared Heritage) which gives due emphasis on the common elements of the different types of traditional textiles produced in the ASEAN region such as songket, ikat, batik, tenun sutra (woven silk) and new innovations introduced in their production.

2) To recognise the importance of the cultural diversity existing in the respective textile producing communities of Southeast Asia, and
