

II. Intangible Cultural Heritage Inventory

There is no inventory at the moment but the need for this has strong support from David Lidimani in his report on Cultural Mapping(2011) Also the Solomon Island National Policy on Culture specifies the need to build a national database and effective system for the management and protection of cultural landscape of archeological and historical significance.

A number of works in the area before Lidimani (2011) are listed here:

In 1993, Japan established with the UNESCO Japanese Funds-in-Trust for the Preservation and Promotion of Intangible Cultural Heritage and by 2013 it had contributed 15.67 million USD and implemented almost 100 projects in the world. A part of this work saw projects on language revitalization in a number of pacific countries for example:

- i) Indigenous Languages: Revitalizations and Preservation in Melanesia and the Pacific (Phase I): Fiji, PNG, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu (June 2000- February, 2003)
- ii) And the (Phase II): January 2006- October 2009.
